Accelerated International Masters Qualifying Program (MQP)

International students who have already completed three years of post-secondary school study in their home country but may require additional support with their English language skills can now transition into a Charles Darwin University masters program in one or two semesters through a combination of discipline-specific subjects with English language support.

Students will gain a deep understanding of the demands of postgraduate study and learn the processes, expectations and methods for success before their masters program begins.

Completion of a higher education program equivalent to AQF Level 6 advanced diploma or associate degrees or relevant work experience.
